

Basic Plesk Control Panel Information

1. To get to your Plesk Control Panel for your hosting with Widomaker, use the following in the address bar of your Browser (i.e. Internet Explorer, Firefox):

<https://www.yourdomainnamehere.tld:8443>



Please note, yes there is an 's' for secure login. Also, www.yourdomainnamehere.tld is your domain name, replace this with that information. (example: www.mycutekitty.com)

When you start to load the page, this warning will come up. Click YES (may be different in Firefox)



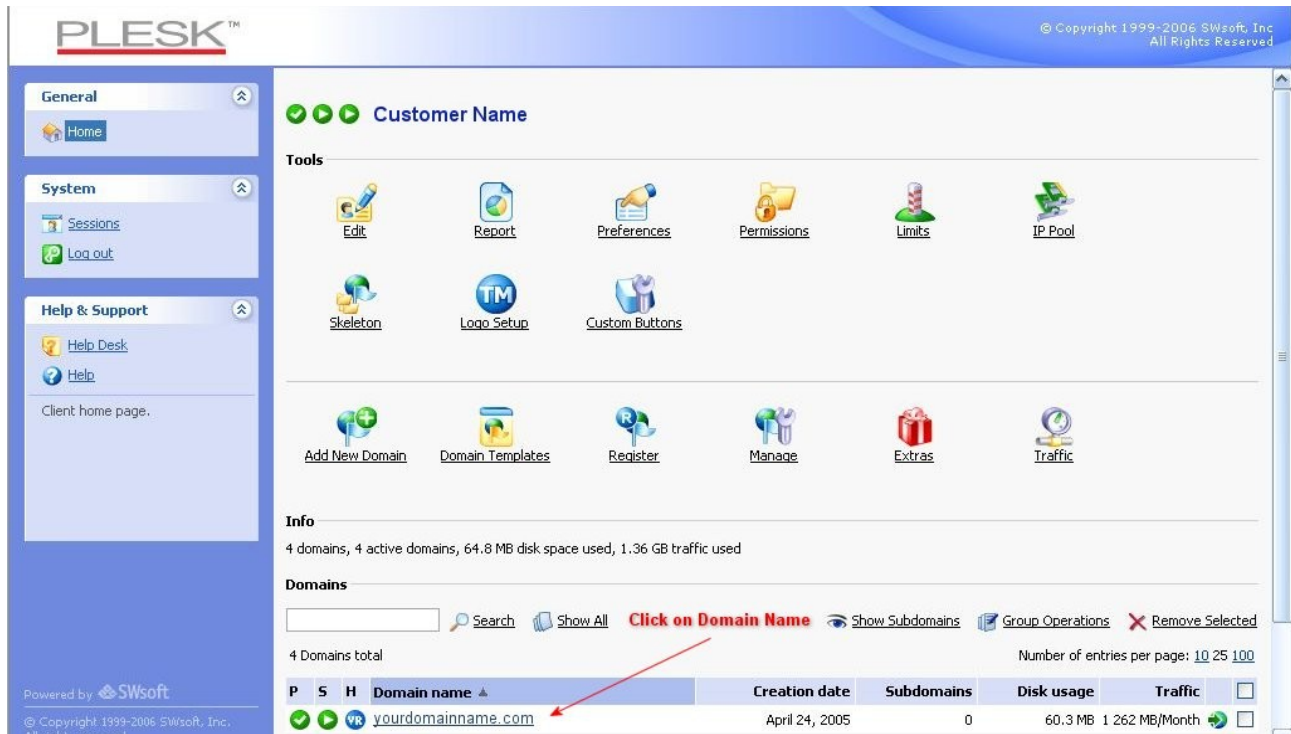
2. You will then see the login page. Enter your 'username and password'. Then click 'LOGIN'. Then you will see the tools available.

- Once logged in, you can access your domain by clicking on the domain name you see setup in the Control Panel.



- Now you see the tools in front of you. You can work with Email, Files, and many other settings. There are help files available for each item once you've clicked into it. Please read if you are in doubt.



- To access your website via FTP, you need the domain name, username and password for your FTP program such as Filezilla, WS_FTP or similar FTP Program. You should not have to change any of the FTP default settings.
